
Baptismal Blanket Instructions

Before you start: Pray for the recipient of the blanket using the prayer on the back or any other you prefer. It's what makes these blankets special!

Basic Instructions:

- 1. Lay the fleece flat on a table. Cut off the selvage (rough) edges from the side opposite the fold. Smooth out the fleece so it is even and cut into 2 pieces by cutting along the fold.
- 2. Cut out a square from each corner using the template.
- 3. Along all four sides, cut slits using the template. Cut through both layers of fleece at one time.
- 4. Tie each fringe pair (top and bottom) in a knot. The knot should be close to the actual blanket. Continue knotting each of the pairs all the way around.

Note our blankets are a bit smaller – and it's fine to use scissors.

When Blanket is Complete: Wrap the blanket in tissue paper and place in the gift bag provided. Return the bag on Saturday, March 6th between 9-11 am. Blankets can also be left at the SRB rectory (call to verify hours). Be sure to let us know who it is from!
